



GAYLORD ROCKIES CIRQUE: SPIRIT OF CHRISTMAS COSTUME ART CONTEST OFFICAL RULES NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN

- Contest Period: Gaylord Rockies Cirque: Spirit of Christmas Costume Art Contest (the "Contest") starts November 2, 2022 at 12:00 a.m. Mountain Time ("MT") and ends November 18, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. MT ("Contest Period")
- 2. Eligibility: Open to legal U.S. residents, residing in Colorado, who are 18 years of age or older as of date of entry and are parents/legal guardians of child(ren) between the ages of 5 and 12. Any Entries received before or after the designated Contest Period will be disqualified. The parent will be deemed the entrant (the "Entrant"). The Entrant must be the parent/legal guardian of child(ren) whose artwork is depicted in the Entry. The Entry must: 1) be complete to be eligible; 2) be the property of the Entrant.
